## **COMPORTMENT**

It has come to the notice of the School Management that majority of the female students have poor management of their braided hair with much emphasis on the Junior school girls. So the School Management has given the go ahead to effect the following changes from NEXT TERM.

- ❖ **ALL Junior School girls will henceforth go on Bi-Weekly hair do. There will be Bi-Weekly hair styles to this effect. Some Junior School girls are yet to comply fully. Parents should please cooperate with the school authority.**
- ❖ **ALL Senior School girls that braid their hair must use only BLACK attachment which must be cut into four (4) parts. Observation shows that some senior students are cutting theirs into three (3) parts.**
- ❖ **No COLOURED attachments. The hair do must be packed in a doughnut form.**
